Woodland Burial



Burial plots are located in Clarefield Meadow & Coquette Glade, both are wild flower meadows surrounded by native woodlands. Memorial trees such as Oak, Rowan and Apple Blossom scatter the meadow, in years to come this will turn the meadow into a thriving woodland and nature reserve.

Ashes plots and traditional burial plots can be purchased in advance or at time of need.

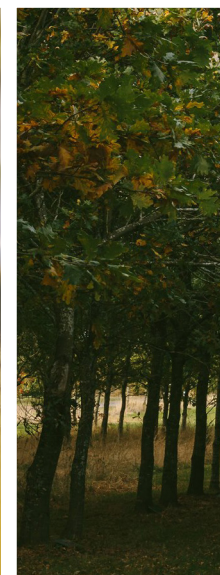
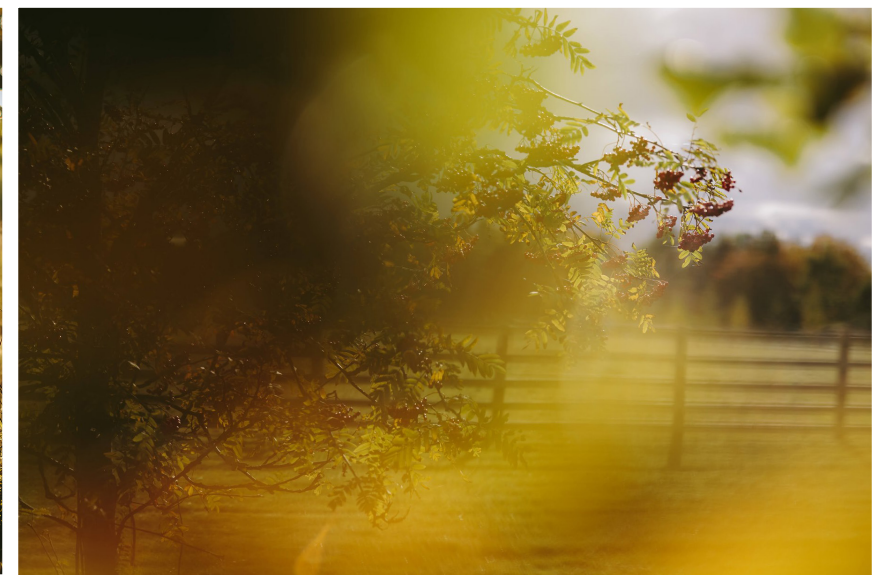


Going Green



Northumberland Crematorium is fitted with a state-of-the-art abatement system to minimise the harmful gases produced during the cremation process. It also benefits from underfloor heating using an innovative heat exchanger that captures and reuses the waste heat produced by the cremator.

In addition, a DeNox filter has been installed, to reduce harmful nitrogen oxides (NOx) released during the cremation process, one of only 9 crematoriums in the UK with such a filter, making it the greenest crematorium in the region.
